Welcome to First Christian Church. I'm glad you are with us this weekend.

This weekend we conclude our current message series called, *My Hope is Built on ... Building a Firm Foundation for Your Belief.* Hope is a word that is often heard in church and among Christian people in regard to their everyday coping system and their expectation for what lies beyond this earthly existence.

The question posed through this series is simply this, "What is your HOPE built on? Do you have a confident foundation for your beliefs? The foundation on which anything is built is critically important, including the things we build our beliefs on. When we speak of HOPE, the HOPE that some speak of sounds more like a hope so kind of hope and not so much of a confident expectation or assurance.

Unlike our world of self-sufficiency, human achievement, awards and halls of fame, the first step into The Kingdom of Heaven happens with the recognition of falling short of the glory of God and it's not deserved. But that's where amazing grace becomes so amazing. The grace of God is more than a song or a religious word. Amazing grace is embodied in the Son of God, Jesus Christ. Much of the New Testament is filled with the writings of a man named Paul who became personally acquainted with God's amazing grace and wrote much about it. To followers of Jesus Christ in the city of Ephesus he wrote... In him [Jesus] we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he [God] lavished on us. (Ephesians 1:7-8 NIV)
